

Homes for station site

RESIDENTS are being urged to learn more, then have their say on plans to redevelop light industrial land into a residential area with major public transport link.

A consultation day will be held from 10am to 1pm on Saturday at Market Square Varsity Lakes.

Transport Minister John Mickel said the Varsity Station Village Vision master plan was being delivered to 4000 households.

The State Government is contributing \$23.7 million to the project on the 14ha site which will include a rail corridor.

The village is planned to coincide with the Robina-Varsity Lakes rail extension and construction is likely to start in 2010.

The village vision would see the land developed into a public transport hub, complete with walking and cycling tracks, parklands, railway station and high density residential development.
